

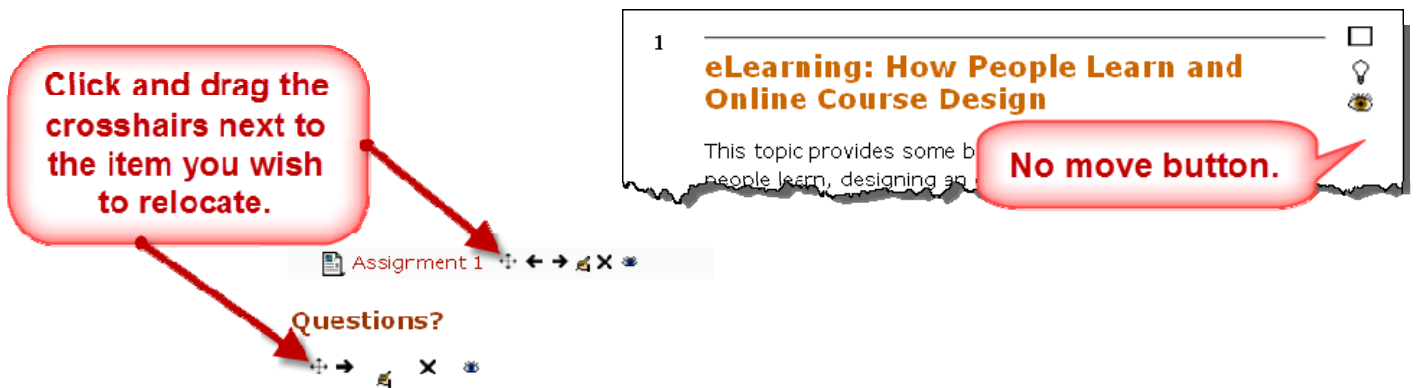
Moodle: Changing Web Features

The AJAX and Javascript web features setting controls the editing tool you use to rearrange blocks, modules, and segments/topics.

- When the AJAX and Javascript is set to No: use basic web features, the buttons to move objects aren't drag and drop, more like click and place. You do have move buttons available to relocate a segment/topic.



- When the AJAX and Javascript is set to Yes: use advanced web features, you have the drag and drop button to use modules, and can drag and drop blocks in your sidebar. You can NOT rearrange segments/topics.



I like to set the option to Yes, since I rarely rearrange segments/topics and more often move everything else. If the occasion arrives when I need to rearrange the segments/topics, then I change this setting to No temporarily.
