

Week 18 Activity Choices

- A. **Present** - Create a power point presentation about the various audio file formats (mp3, mp4, acc, wav, etc). Each slide should discuss one file type and show what the file type is, whether it is lossy or lossless, and what type of computers/programs use that format.
- B. **Perform** -Compose a digital song. You can use an online writing program such as Noteflight or JamStudio, or a mixing program such as Fruity Loops, Garage Band, etc. The song must be completely digital and be at least 1 minute long.
- C. **Essay** - Research the two sides of mp3 filesharing and the history of Napster. Choose a side of the debate and persuade the listener to believe in your side. Discuss issues such as privacy, cost of an album, and legality.
