-This weeks assignment is a little different. You have until the END OF THE QUARTER to complete this assignment:

1. Attend a musical performance in a classical venue (concert band, choir, orchestra).
This could be a school performance or a professional performance. Check with the schools nearby for upcoming performances.
2. Keep a copy of the program or be sure to know what pieces were performed.
3. Write a report (in essay form) answering the following questions:
 - a. What was the name of the performing group?
 - b. What pieces did the group perform and who were the composers?
 - c. Where did you attend the concert?
 - d. What did you notice about the etiquette of the audience during the performance? Was it good, bad? Did people text or talk. Be as specific as possible about the behavior.
 - e. How did you enjoy the concert? What specific musical aspects did you enjoy and/or not enjoy?
 - f. How was YOUR etiquette? Was it hard to follow the rules? Do you feel the etiquette rules make a difference in relation to enjoying the performance?
