Game Rules.

- 1) Players will take turns.
- 2) When it is your turn, ask another player for a card that will make a match with a card you already have.
- 3) Rules about asking:
 - If you already have a job title card, you must ask for the *job description*.

- 4) It is OK to use your cheat sheet to help you ask correctly.
- 5) If you do not follow Rule #3 when asking for a card, you forfeit your turn.
- 6) If the player has the card you asked for, that player must give the card to you. In that case, you may ask any player for another card.
- 7) If the player does not have the card you asked for, they will tell you to "Go Fish." Draw a card from the pile.
- 8) When you get a matching pair of cards, set your pair aside and color in a circle next to the correct person on the game board.
- 9) At the end of the period, the player with the most colored circles wins!
