

GeoGebra Assignment Instructions:


When you are ready to demonstrate your understanding of points, lines, and planes, find an image so that you can highlight these concepts.

1. Find an image on the Internet or upload one from your phone or camera.

**The image must be saved so that you can access it.

2. Open the GeoGebra Applet using the link below.

3. In order to insert an image, you will need to change the GeoGebra toolbar.

Along the top of the page, find the  button.


Click in the bottom right corner. Scroll down and click "insert image".

The  button should appear.

4. Watch the YouTube video to learn how to insert the image you found.

5. Once you have inserted the image, use GeoGebra to label points ,

line segments and lines , and use a text box  to describe a plane

(this is found in the same menu as the  button).

If you double click on a point, line, or line segment, you can change the color and/or thickness by clicking on "object properties".

6. Once you have completely labeled your image, save the GeoGebra (you will need to upload it in the GeoGebra Assignment link).
