Found a bug?

If you've found an obvious bug that doesn't really need discussion, please post it directly in the [Moodle Tracker](#). Include as much relevant detail as possible so that others can understand and reproduce the bug.

If possible, research and include a solution to the bug – this really helps the [core developers](#) include a fix into Moodle as soon as possible.

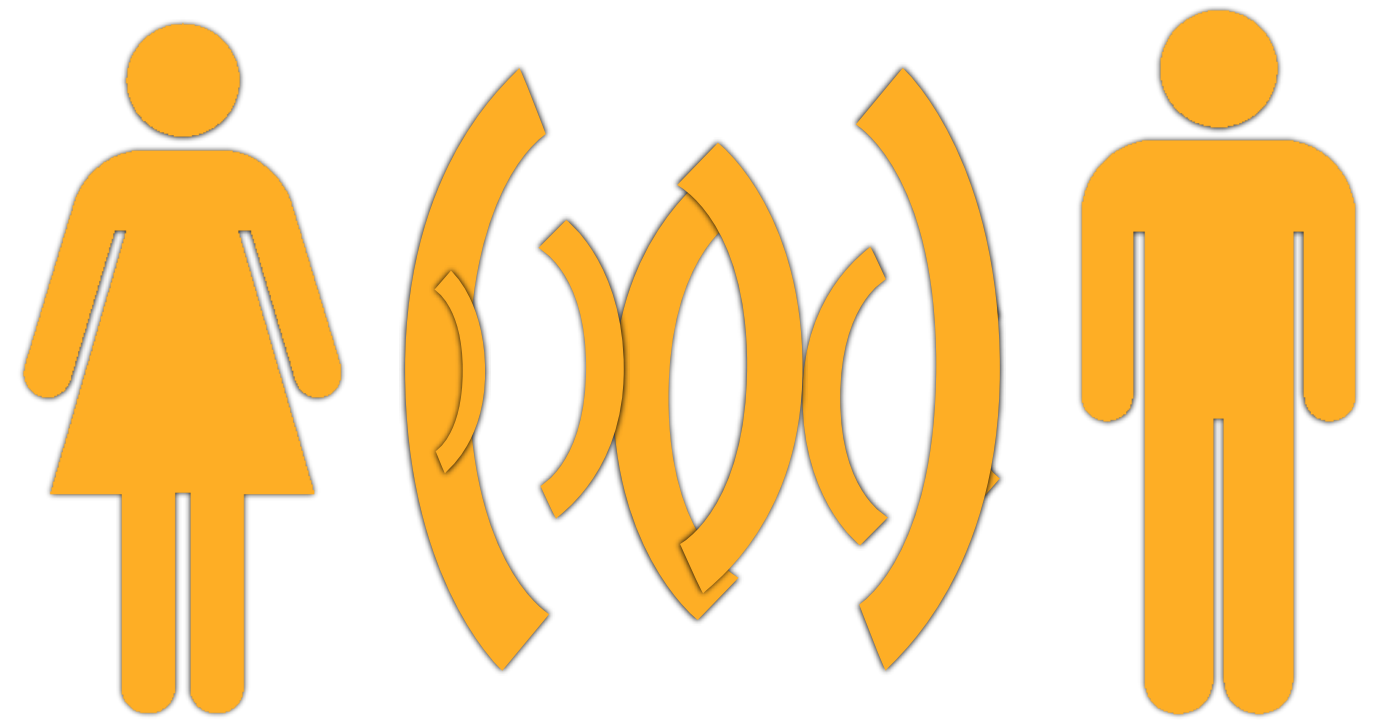
Want to help?

As a participant in the longer term, you should consider what you are **putting in to the community** as well as what you are getting out of it. Here are some suggestions:

- If you see an unanswered question from someone and you know the answer to it, then answer it!
- Add ratings to other people's postings so that they get some feedback. Ratings are also used to determine [particularly helpful Moodlers](#).
- Transfer useful content from forum discussions, such as frequently asked questions and answers, or ideas/suggestions of ways of using a particular feature, to the [Moodle documentation wiki](#).
- If you have a suggestion for a new feature, provide a mock screenshot so people can see exactly what you are talking about. If you know some coding, then snippets of code are always appreciated.
